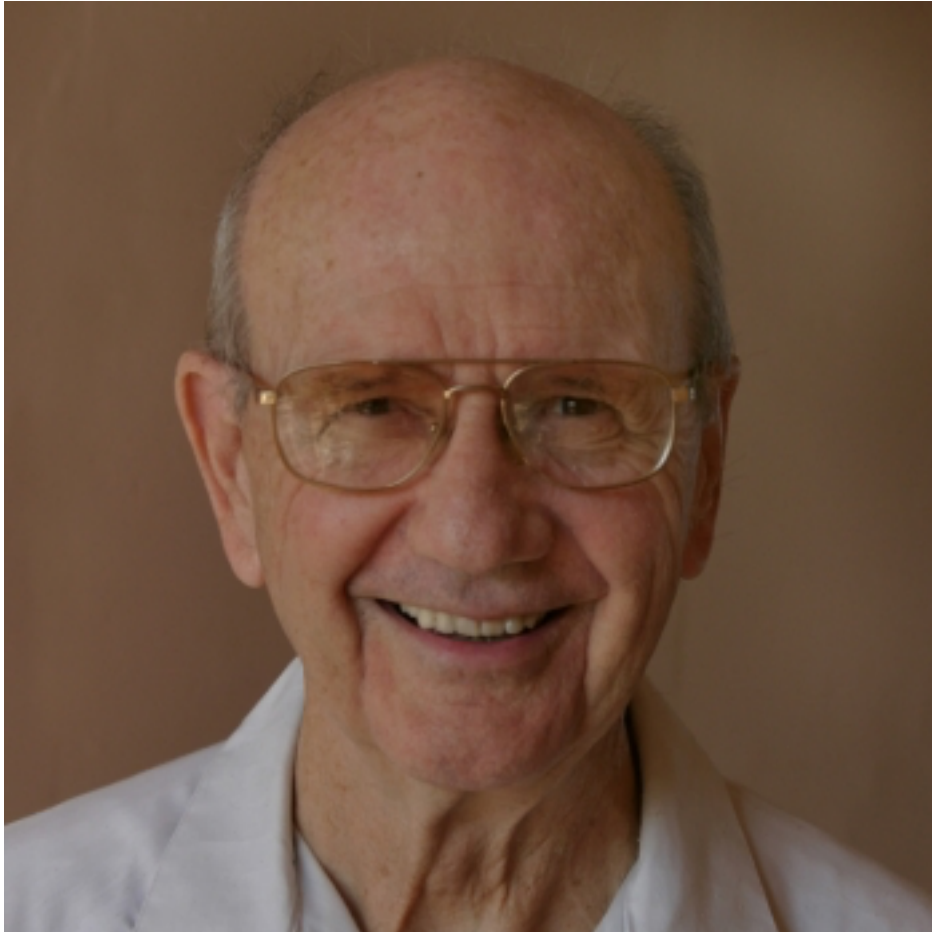


FATHER JAMES SHORT
